West Gate Tunnel Project

\$1,500,000,000

Client: John Holland

This CPB/John Holland JV is responsible for delivering the West Gate Tunnel Project.

The Westgate Tunnel Project project was significant for its scale and the magnitude of planning required. We were responsible for the dual lift of the seal rings for the tunnel boring machine (TBM). We used hydraulic lifting rams to rotate the seal rings at the correct angle for insertion into the entrance of tunnel. Two cranes, a 220T crane and a 350T crane, were used during this lift

Tulla Widening

This CPB/LendLease JV will add extra lanes in each direction between the Bolte Bridge and Melbourne Airport, as well as extra lanes on the Bolte Bridge and a section of the West Gate Freeway (eastbound) between Bolte Bridge and Power Street.

By separating traffic at key locations along the 24km project and upgrading interchanges, it will also relieve much of the weaving and merging on the freeway that contributes to congestion and crashes.

Melbourne Jet Base

Melbourne Jet Base is a world class facility offering the highest levels of safety, security and services available around the clock. We were responsible for 100T, 75m long curved truss to be installed, rotate to vertical, then install. Four cranes were used in the beginning, then it became a dual lift, 200T and 220T crane, 80t. Due to the installation method, the steel had to be held on the crane hook for 7 hours whilst the remainder of the steel was being secured in place.

2018

State Library Victoria

Premier Cranes and Rigging worked with tight access in the back lane for access and often utilised the full capacity of our 100T crane and fly within this narrow space. Our design team modelled the proposed lifts in CAD and provided our builder with lift plans before the scheduled works. By scheduling the same crew, they established a good understanding of the site restrictions, considerations of the live pedestrian traffic and the close proximity of all the surrounding buildings.



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
